All persons entering any courtroom must dress and act in a respectful manner.

Attire should be clean and neat.

No halter tops, tank tops, shorts, exposed underwear, flip flops, bedroom slippers, or sunglasses.

No clothing with rude, obscene, or vulgar wording or pictures.

Trousers are to be worn at the waistline and shirt tails are to be tucked in.

Backs, midriffs, and stomachs are to be covered at all times.

With religious and medical exception, no hats, head scarves, headbands, or kerchiefs may be worn.
