The courses listed above have been approved by the Office of the Executive Secretary for continuing education credit for qualified Guardians Ad Litem for Incapacitated Persons. In addition to the live programs being offered this calendar year, program options include replays of entire courses and replays of individual sessions from courses previously offered. Guardians Ad Litem who repeat a course for which credit was previously received, or who repeat an individual session from a course for which credit was previously received, will receive a one-time continuing education credit for such repetition if at least 4 years has passed since the original date of course completion. Please note that continuing education credit will be awarded for the initial course, "Representation of Incapacitated Persons as a Guardian Ad Litem," once at any time after initial qualification, and then not again for 6 years.
