In the Supreme Court of Virginia held at the Supreme Court Building in the City of Richmond on Thursday the 1st day of November, 2012.

It is ordered that the Rules heretofore adopted and promulgated by this Court and now in effect be and they hereby are amended to become effective immediately.

Amend a portion of Rule 3A:17.1 to read as follows:

Rule 3A:17.1. Proceedings in Bifurcated Jury Trials of Non-Capital Felonies and Class 1 misdemeanors.

(h) Non-Unanimous Jury at the Penalty Phase. -- Should the jury fail to reach unanimous agreement as to punishment on any charge for which it returned a verdict of guilty, the court shall impanel a different jury to ascertain punishment, unless the defendant, the attorney for the Commonwealth and the court agree that the court shall fix punishment in the manner provided in Section 19.2-257, for the offense upon which the jury unanimously returned a verdict of guilty.
