Assignment of Error

- 1. The Court of Appeals erred in affirming the judgment of the Richmond City Trial Court, denying Barlow's motion to suppress
 - A. The Court of Appeals erred in finding that there was reasonable articulable suspicion to seize Barlow
 - B. The Court of Appeals erred in finding that there was reasonable articulable suspicion that Barlow was armed and presently dangerous to justify a pat-down search of his person
 - C. The Court of Appeals erred in finding that any strip search of Barlow was not a violation of the Fourth Amendment
