# Roadmap for the VA Mediation Certification Process<sup>1</sup>

## Certification levels (most common)

- General District Court (GDC)
- Juvenile & Domestic Relations (JDR)
  Circuit Court Family (CCF)
- Circuit Court Civil (CCC)

## **Training** – Core courses required for all certification levels:

- Basic mediation 20-hour core course or waiver for out-of-state training
- VA Judicial System 4-hour orientation core course, waiver for VSB attorney's Family (JDR and CCF), must take in addition:
- Family mediation 20-hour core course (i.e. custody, visitation, support)
- Domestic abuse screening before mediation 8-hour core course

**Advanced** – Circuit Court level mediation:

- Circuit Court Civil 12-hour core course (i.e. complex civil and multi-party disputes)
- Circuit Court Family 20-hour core course (i.e. divorce and equitable asset distribution)

## **Mentorship** – observations and co-mediations with VA certified mentor:

**Observations** – two per level, or one at Circuit level with prior certification

One or both may be substituted with level specific 4 or 8-hour observation course

**Co-Mediations** – minimum required cases and hours

**GDC** 3 cases / 5 hours **CCC** 5 cases / 10 hours (2 cases with prior GDC) **JDR** 5 cases / 10 hours **CCF** 5 cases / 10 hours (2 cases with prior JDR)

#### **Required forms and Memoranda:**

- Application for Mediator Certification (<u>Form ADR-1000A</u>)
- ADR 1008 Mentee Portfolio form each co-mediation
- ADR 1001 Mentee Evaluation form each co-mediation; Mentee complete Sect IV
- Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) one per each level certification desired
  - o For JDR and CCF Custody, Visitation, Child Support Calculations Worksheet, by hand
  - o For CCF Agreement must include equitable distribution of assets
