Pittsylvania County Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court Fines and Costs Time to Pay Policy

- Court Fines and Costs are due within 90 days of assessment. After 90 days your account can be sent to collections and will have collection costs added.
- If you are unable to pay within 90 days you may sign a payment plan agreement for deferred payment in full.
 You will be assessed an additional one-time fee of \$10.00 per payment agreement.
- If you are unable to pay in full by the date listed on your initial payment plan agreement you may request additional time to pay your fines and costs in full.
- You may pay any amount you wish, at any time, during the deferred payment time.
- Interest will begin accruing on day 181 after your trial date with no payment agreement unless you are incarcerated, then it is 181 days following release date from incarceration.
- If your sole financial resource is a Social Security benefit or Supplemental Security Income, then you are not required to pay until you have another resource or income. As long as your sole income remains unchanged, your account will not go to collections. Please understand that any restitution you may have been ordered to pay is not included in this exemption of payment and is due as the court has ordered.
